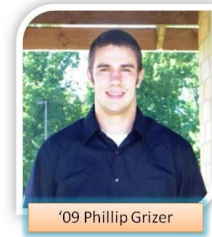

The Original Hornet *Where did it come from?*

During the 1946-47 basketball season, the team was given new 'yellow' warm-up jackets by a local minister, Reverend Bruner. His son

Dick played for the Summit High basketball team and they soon referred to the team as the Yellow Jackets. As the story goes, the fans would cheer on the new 'Yellow Jackets' followed by the cheer to 'Sting-em'.

During the 1951-52 school year the school officially adopted the name of the Summit Hornets.

During the 1958-59 school year, on April 17th the Jersey School and Summit School was consolidated. A contest was held to name the newly formed district. Ruth Appleman won the grand prize of \$10 for the winning entry. That's when the district officially became known as:

The Licking Heights Hornets
