School District Announces Budget Reduction Plans

School Board President Matt Satterwhite states that the District is required to operate with a balanced budget. The 2007 emergency levy is about to expire and expenses and inflation have increased since passage in 2007 leaving the district facing a sizeable shortfall. A levy will be voted on in May to renew the expiring levy plus 3 mill. The Board only requested 3 mill despite knowing it would still leave a \$1.5 million deficit. They did not feel a 17-18 mill would be received well by the community. Mr. Satterwhite said that they must reduce the budget \$1.5 million if the levy passes and \$5 million if the levy were to fail.

The Board wanted to be clear that failure of this levy will have catastrophic consequences impacting everything they do in the district. The \$5 million in cuts would be felt throughout the school and community. The buildings would not be open for community events or youth sport activities, our own extra-curricular activities will have to be self-funded (estimates are around \$475 per student, per activity, sport, band, etc..., with no cap).
